


We believe that:

Bio Guayusa

Inci: Ilex Guayusa

Guayusa is a natural energizer for both body and mind. Is a tree that grows in the Ecuadorian Amazon rainforest, distantly related to the yerba mate. With a mild flavor and pleasant aroma, its large leaves are rich in caffeine and at the same time it contains L-theanine, an amino acid, that transmits a pleasant feeling of tranquility.

Organic Moringa

Inci: Moringa Oleifera

Very commonly used in food and beauty industries for its numerous therapeutic properties, its highly antioxidant power also highlights its supply of essential amino acids. Bio Lyophilized Açai

Inci: Euterpe Oleracea Fruit

Açai (pronounced: assai) is the fruit of a palm tree that only grows in wild state in the Amazon rainforests and is processed under the system of lyophilization. Its flavor reminds of a mixture of berries and chocolate, to wild strawberry with a touch of grape.

Rich in proteins, lipids, vitamins (C, E, B1, B2) and minerals (phosphorus, calcium and iron) and high contents of anthocyanins (flavonoid group). It is highly energetic, it fights away fatigue and helps with the intestinal functions.

It can be used in juices, ice-creams, milkshakes, bowls, cosmetics and health.

Pitahaya

Inci: Hylocereus Undatus

Pitahaya, also known as dragon fruit, is originally from Central America. It has an oval shape, it can be found in two different varieties:

Yellow on the outside and white pulp;

Red on the outside and white pulp;

It is very aromatic and with a very sweet and pleasant taste. Its seeds, that are edible, contain beneficial fatty acids.

Avocado

Inci: Persea Americana

The pulp is an oily creamy yellowish green, with a flavor reminiscent of hazelnut. The color of the skin depends on the variety and does not indicate the degree of maturity of the fruit. The best moment for its consumption is marked by the softness of the pulp.

Currently, the Sacha Inchi seed is gaining worldwide prominence because for its nutritional value which comes from its high content of essential polyunsaturated fatty acids.

Equally, the oil extracted from this seed is considered the best for domestic human consumption.
